CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Students will maintain a proper attitude pertaining to the event.
2. No tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, firearms, knives, fireworks, or other inappropriate items.
3. Cell phones, tablets, or handheld video games are allowed for the bus ride but must be put away during sessions and lights out. Students must adhere to the Cell phone Policy on the next page.
4. Students will treat adults courteously and with respect. Students will also treat their fellow peers with respect.
5. Students will dress modestly. (No halter tops, midriffs showing, short shorts, short skirts, two-piece swimsuits, clothing with inappropriate slogans or advertising)
6. No inappropriate jokes or pranks (Those that cause harm to a person, property or result in the humiliation of another person)
7. Students will attend all activities at the event and be on time. Exceptions must be pre-approved by Barry.
8. Students will maintain appropriate physical space between males and females. No public displays of affection (handholding, sitting on lap, kissing, etc..)
9. Students will abide by any rules that may be applied in addition to those on this list while at an event.
10. Barry may send any student home if deemed necessary at the parents expense.

Cell Phone & Electronic Devices Policy

- Cell phones, tablets and other electronic devices will be allowed on bus rides or while we're away from the event space (Cabin, hotel, etc) but if any adult sees a student using their device for any type of bullying or participating in anything deemed vulgar or inappropriate by an adult, the student's device will be confiscated by an adult and returned at Barry's discretion.
- All phones and electronic devices must stay in the sleeping quarters during worship and free time. We are here to fellowship with one another and disconnect from our devices. If you need to contact your child during a worship session or free time, please contact Barry or another adult chaperone and we will have your child contact you immediately.
- If any student is found to not adhere to this policy, we will first warn, then we will take the device for the day, and if again they will lose their device until we return home.

Cabin/Lodge/ Sleeping Room Policy

- The sleeping rooms are to be for sleeping/showering/bathroom use ONLY. This is not a place to seclude yourself or gather with your friends and gossip (in person or on social media/SnapChat, etc). All students, unless sleeping, using the bathroom, or contacting parents will be asked to stay in the common areas of the cabin/lodge.
- No guys in girls rooms or girls in guys room. You should only be in your assigned room.

Group Outing Policy

- When we are out, all students are to be in a group of at least 4 people, with at least 1 person having a CHARGED cell phone.
- If any group is found not to have 4 people or if they do not meet at the appointed meeting time and place, then they will have to join an adult for the remainder of the trip.
